The Busko-Zdrój Health Resort

The resort is surrounded by intact nature. In the radius of 50 km, there are no industrial activities so you can enjoy clean air. Here you can improve your health, regain your fitness and cure many ailments through natural therapies and a wide range of physiotherapy procedures.

Natural sources of healing mineral water support the treatment of arthritis-related, neurological, cardiological, dermatological and chiropodical ailments or illnesses. Children and adults affected by cerebral palsy are efficiently rehabilitated there. The resort provides



spa treatment, hospital treatment, rehabilitation treatment, outpatient medical treatment, referral and privately paid rehabilitation stays and recreational stays. Technologically advanced and modern medical equipment helps in the treatment process. The scope of services has been expanded for spa & wellness procedures.
